Why was it so difficult to put the fire out?

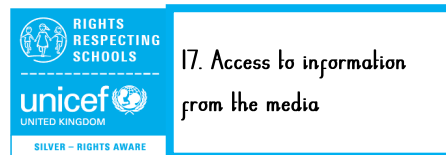
How do we know about the Great Fire of London?
